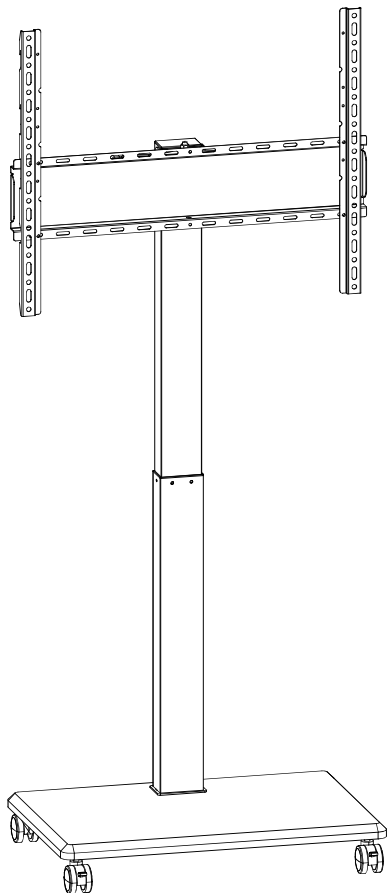

Do not touch the surface with a hard/sharp object that may cause scratching.



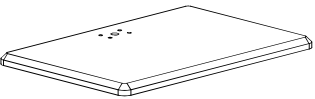
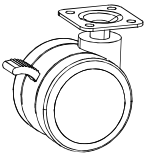
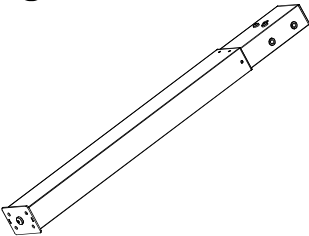
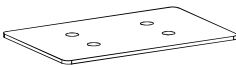
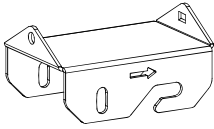
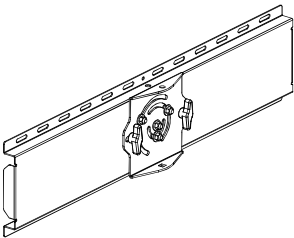
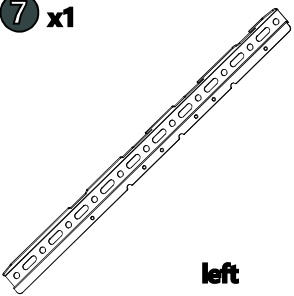
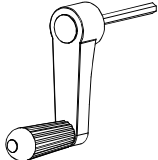

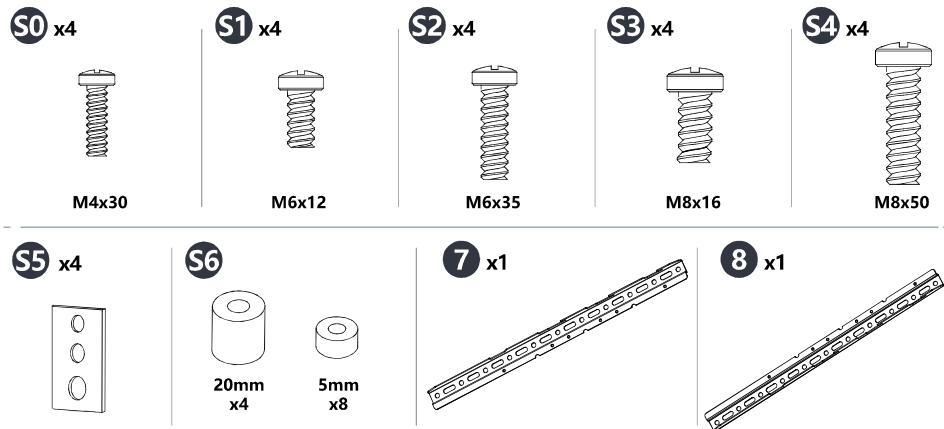


Install the upper pipe clamp screw with its head facing backward.





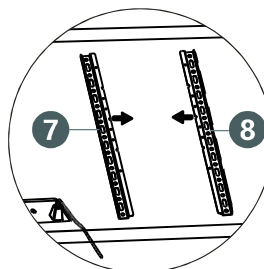
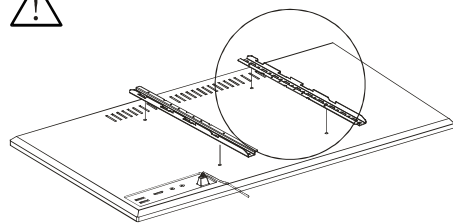
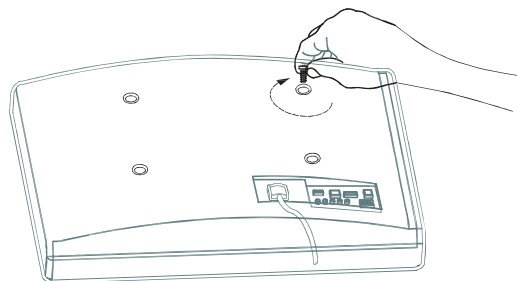
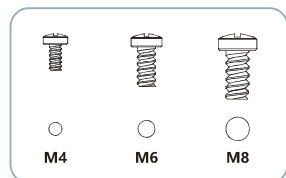

STEP 1

Select TV Screw Diameter

Please make sure the diameter of the screw **S0-S4** are suitable for your TV.



Install with the folded edge facing inward.

STEP 2

Measure VESA For Your TV

1. What does the VESA standard mean?

The VESA standard is a standard for attaching flat screens / LCD / monitors / televisions to monitor mounts or TV mounts.

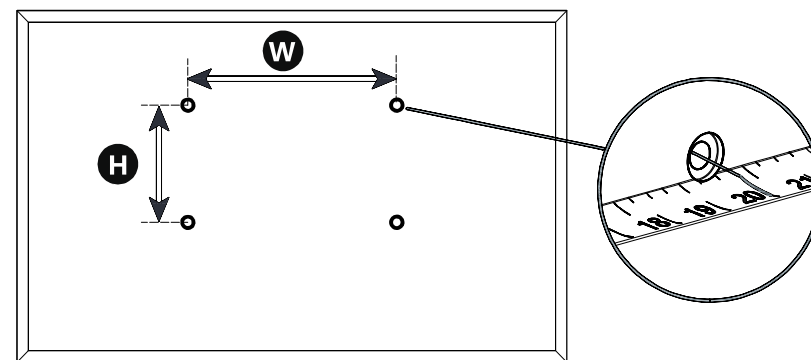
Prerequisite is that both the monitor / TV and the monitor mount have the same VESA standard.

2. Look at the back of your TV/monitor for threaded holes.

Measure the horizontal distance **W** and vertical distance **H** of the screw holes (center to center).

W x **H** should comply with the VESA standard of TV stand listed in below sheet.

Notice: If the TV/monitor is not compatible with VESA, it can still be attached to the desired bracket by using VESA Adapters(not included and should be purchased separately).

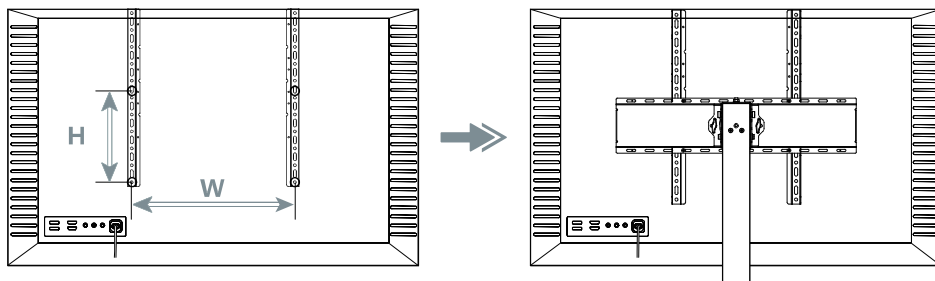
VESA standard of TV STAND

STEP 3

Holes Selection of Brackets

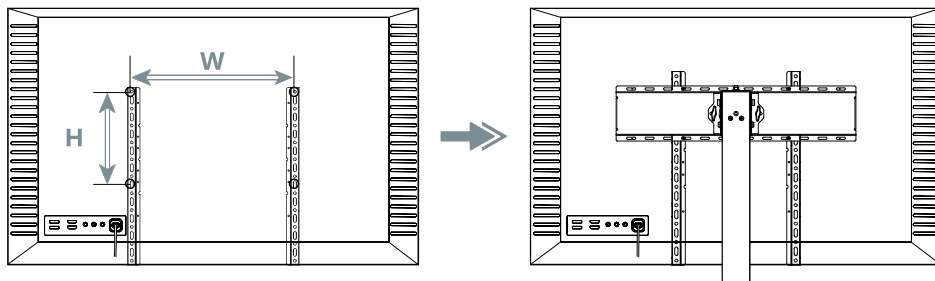
When **H** is shorter than 500mm, different TV heights can be set based on bracket hole positions, as shown in the following figure.

Choose the lower holes to lower the TV height

Choose the upper holes to raise the TV height

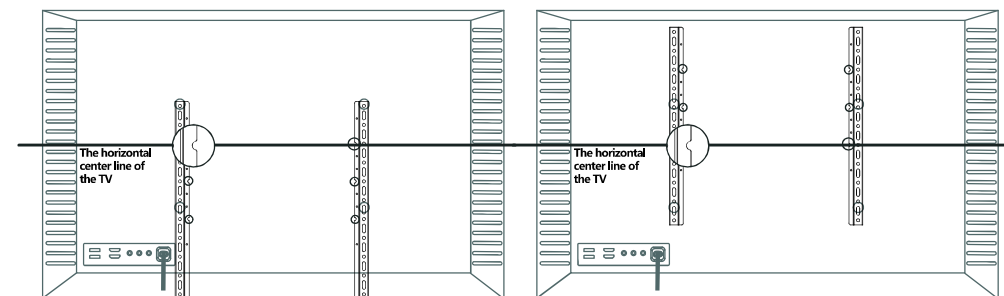
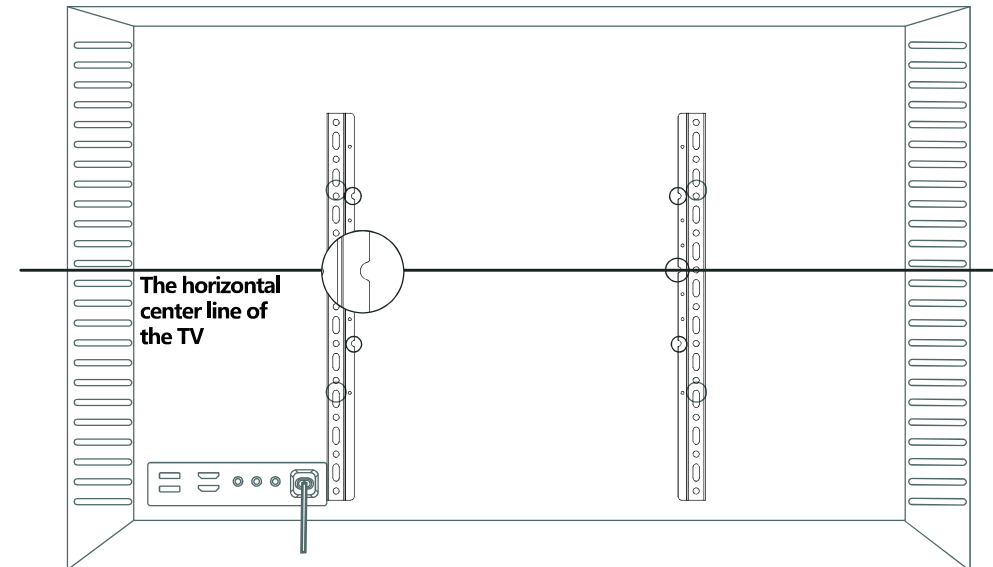

STEP 4

Hook installation precautions

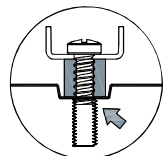
When installing, align any one of the three arc-shaped notches at the folded edge of hook **7** / **8** with the center line of the TV as close as possible according to the height of the notch, and then fix it.



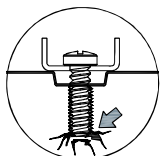
STEP 5

Select TV Screw Length

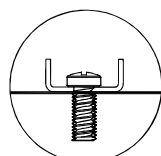
When attaching brackets to the TV, be careful not to over tighten screws and be sure that screws don't bottom out in the mounting holes. Please make sure the length of thread engagement at least 6 turns or 8mm.



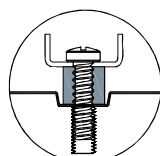

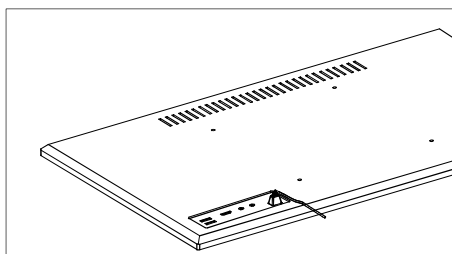

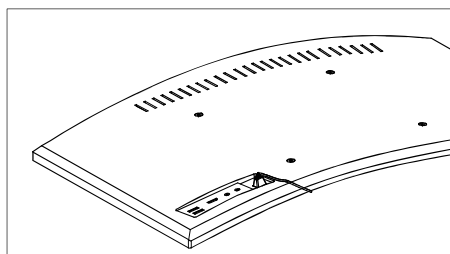

Select installation method according to TV

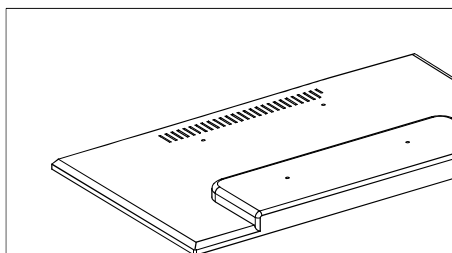
⚠ Please confirm the style of the TV backplane before installation and select the corresponding installation method



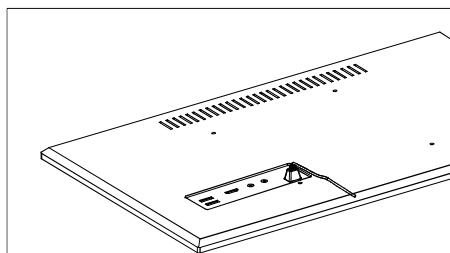
For flat back TV,

Option 4 (Potential Cable Blockage)

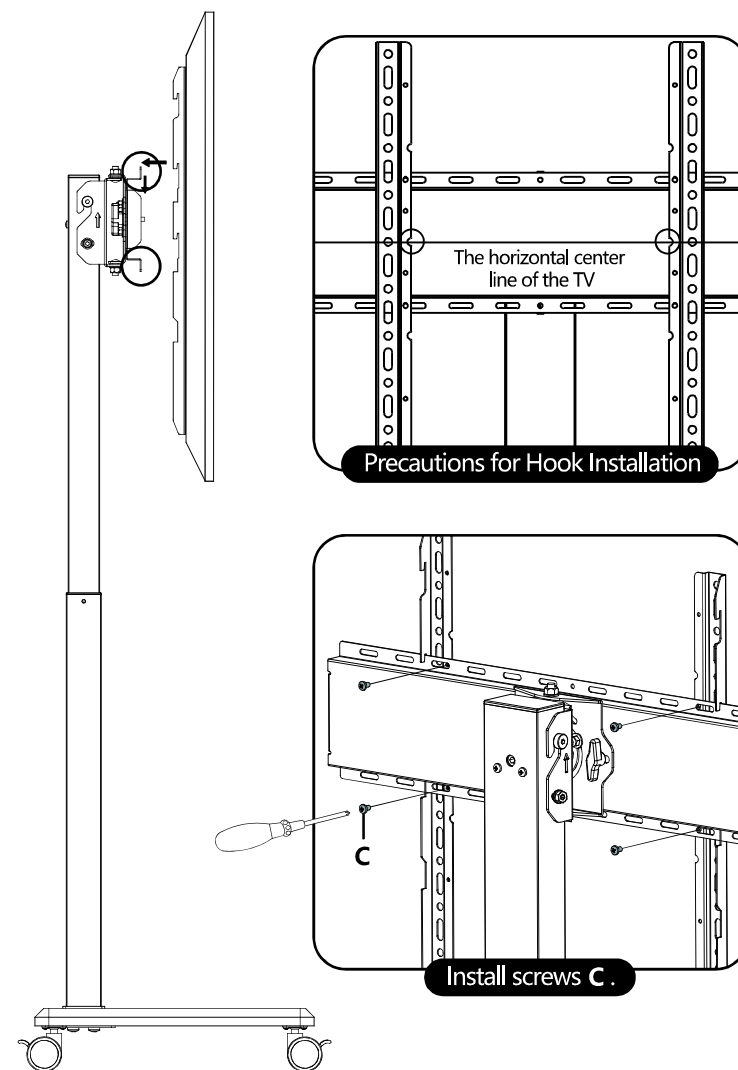
Spacers may be necessary when cables or plug/outlets are blocked by brackets.

When installing, align one of the arc-shaped notches of hook 7/8 with the TV's center line, position it centrally, and then install it onto the hanging plate.

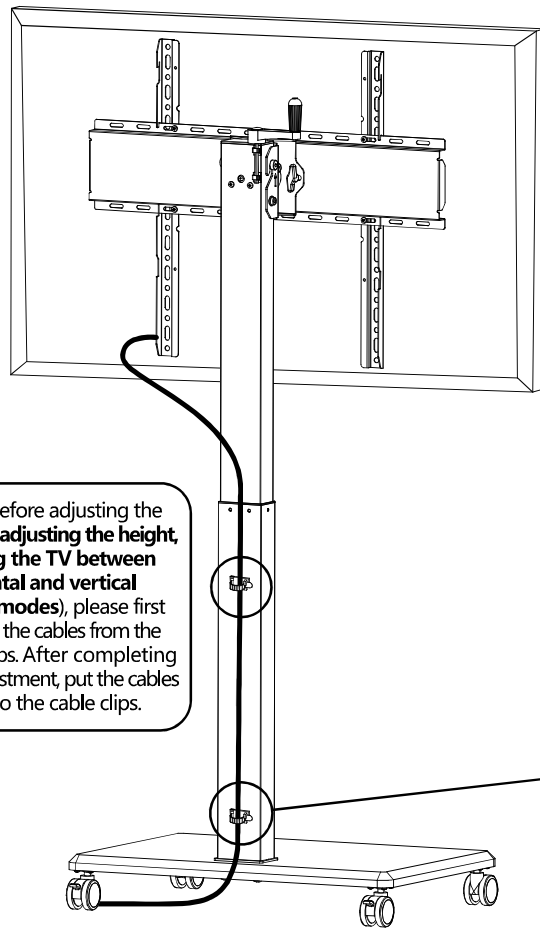

L₃ x2 

Cable management clips L₃ lets you easily organize power and AV cords to keep things neat.

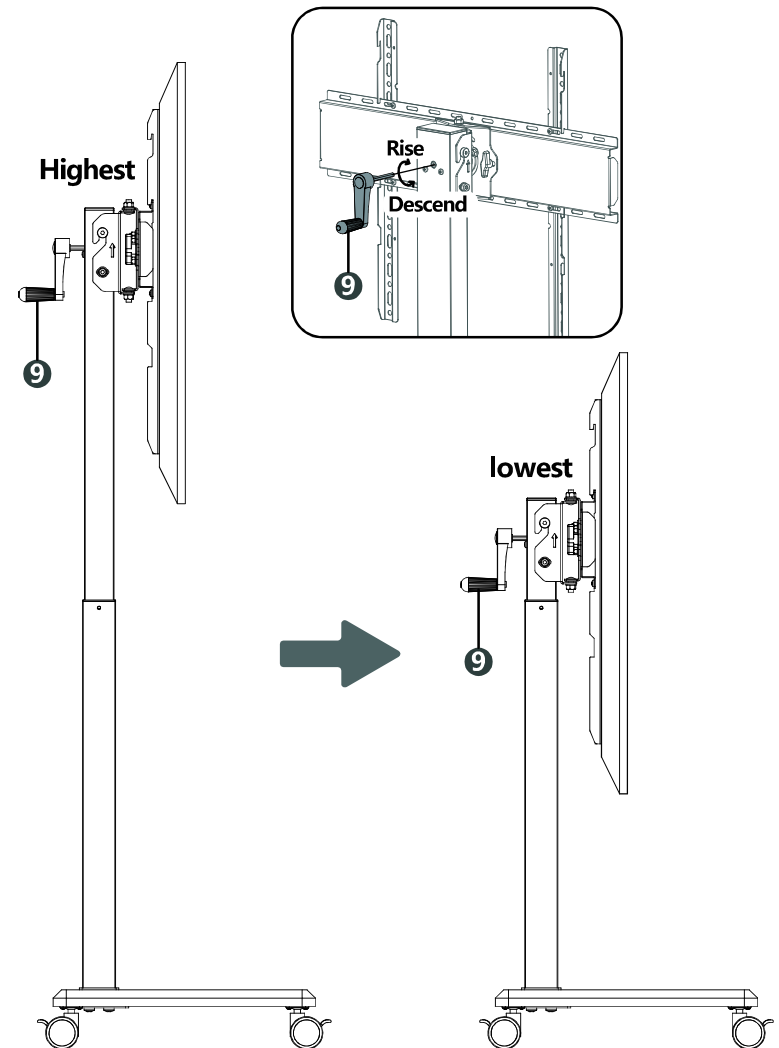


! Note: Before adjusting the TV (e.g., adjusting the height, rotating the TV between horizontal and vertical screen modes), please first remove the cables from the cable clips. After completing the adjustment, put the cables back into the cable clips.

USER GUIDELINES

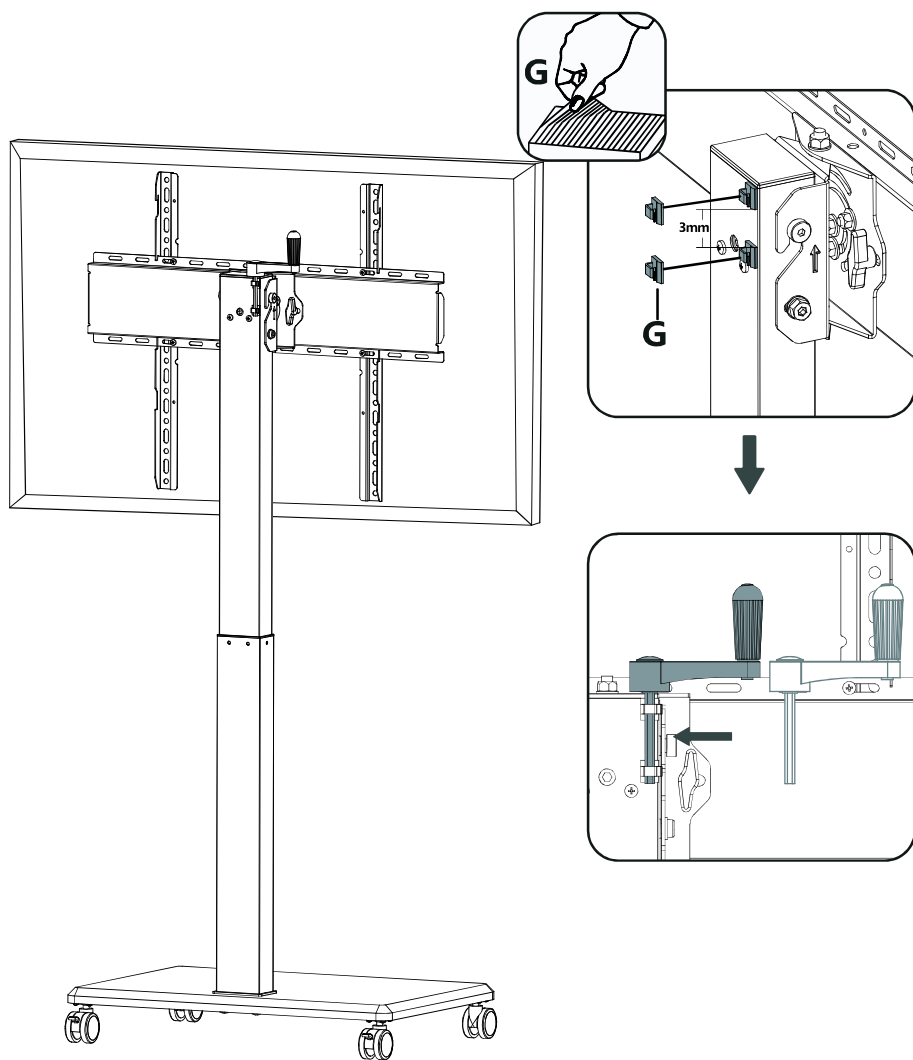
Vertical pole height adjustment

Use rocker arm ⑨ to adjust the height of the vertical pole (turn clockwise to raise the vertical pole; turn counterclockwise to lower the vertical pole).



Winding Handle Storage

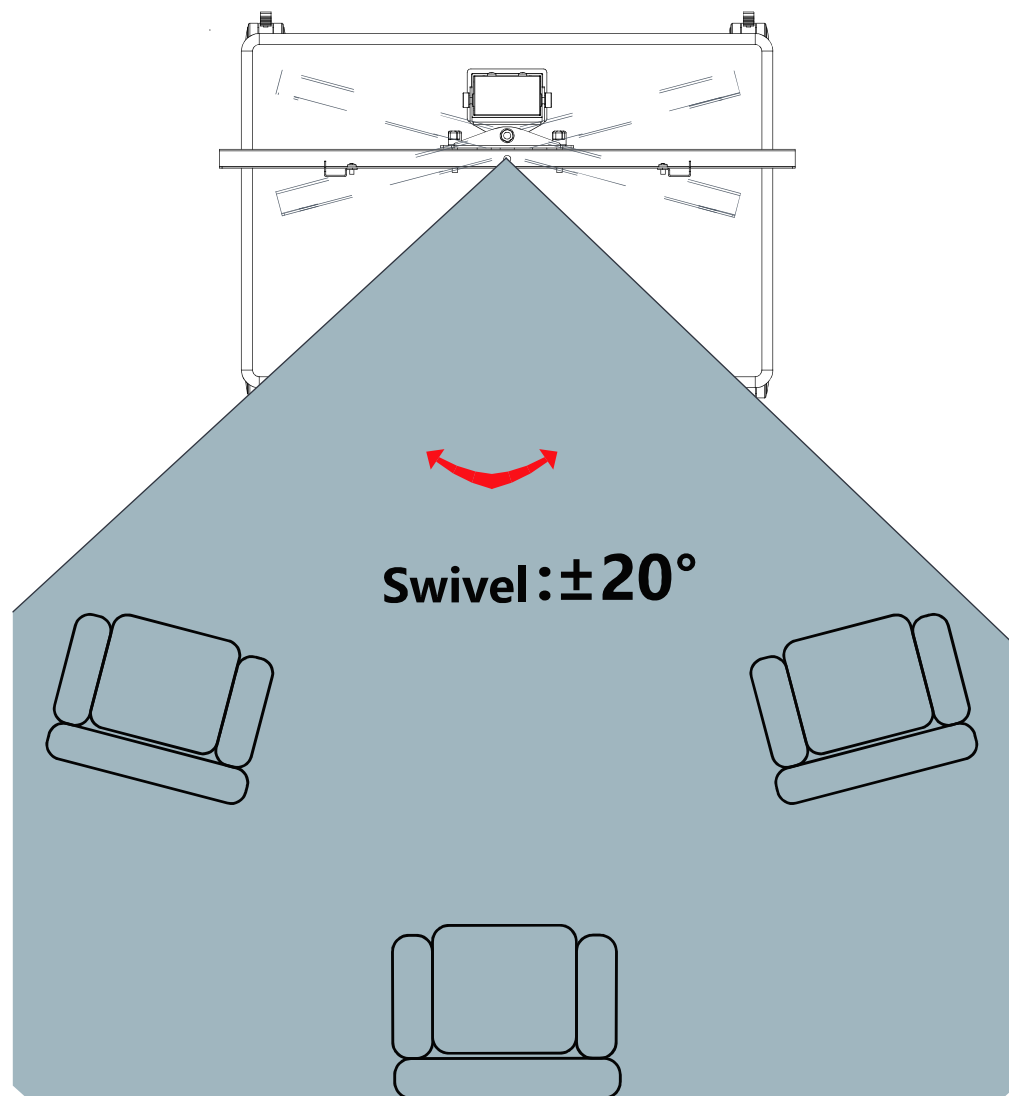
Attach one clip **G** to the top of the upper pole (flush with the top plastic part), and attach the other clip **G** **3cm** below the first one, aligned with it.



Viewing Angle Adjustment

TV plate **6** can swivel left and right **20** degrees to provide you a wide-range of viewing angles when watching the TV.

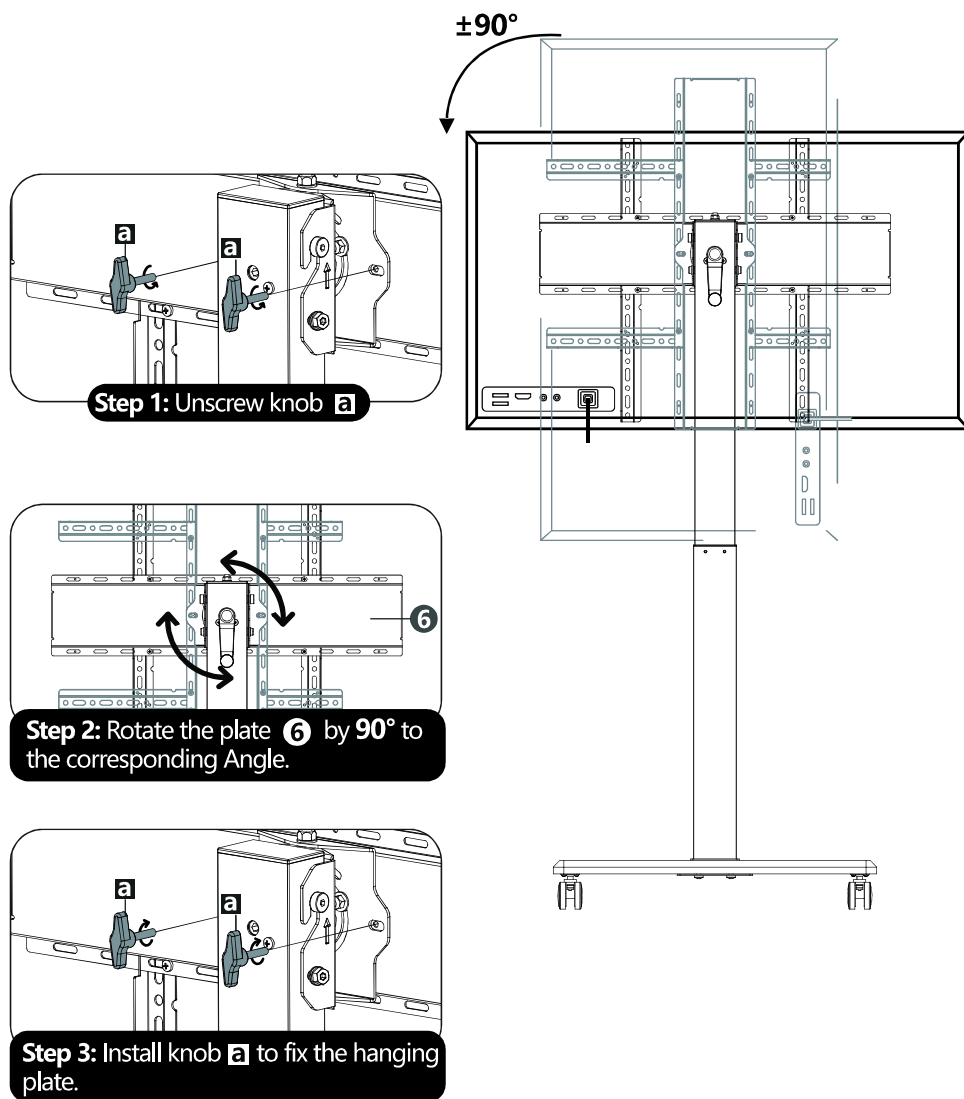
Note - Swivel function is manual, not automatic.
Base is not turntable.



Landscape – Portrait Adjustment

The TV plate ⑥ can rotate **90** degrees to the left and right respectively, providing you with a better viewing angle.

Note- Tilt function is manual, not automatic.



MOVE EASILY

The stand can be moved easily when required. Before moving the stand, make sure all wheels are unlocked and keep your hands in a comfortable position on the stand, as shown below, to maintain control and prevent it from tipping over.

For longer distances, we recommend removing the TV and any other equipment from the stand before moving it.

Take extra care when moving the stand over carpet, uneven surfaces, thresholds or other obstacles.
